

**2010-2011 Money Tree Raffle  
Rules & Regulations**

**Pursuant to Massachusetts General Law C. 271s.7A, Saint Anne's Hospital hereby states the following disclosure relative to the Money Tree Raffle:**

1. The 2010-2011 Money Tree Raffle (MTR) is a raffle sponsored by the Friends of Saint Anne's Hospital to benefit Saint Anne's Hospital. All net proceeds will be applied to the Friends of Saint Anne's Hospital's current pledge to Saint Anne's Hospital, raffle prizes and the 2011 Grand Prize Raffle Celebration.
2. All persons are eligible with the exception of The Friends of Saint Anne's MTR Chair and Office of Development MTR liaison and their immediate families.
3. There is no limit to the number of tickets one may purchase.
4. The raffle shall begin if, and only if, 125 raffle tickets have been sold by Friday, March 19, 2010. If the raffle is not fully subscribed by this date, all agreements of ticket purchases shall be terminated immediately and all money will be reimbursed.
5. A maximum limit of 500 raffle tickets will be sold by the sponsoring committee.
6. In the event that only the minimum number of tickets are sold, an estimated 10% of the ticket price will be used for charitable purposes. If the maximum number of tickets are sold, an estimated 70% of the ticket price will be used for charitable purposes.
7. Payment will proceed as such: a) participant may join at any time during the raffle year by paying a total of \$250; or b) a participant may pay quarterly payments of \$62.50 to be paid by 3/19/10, 6/4/10, 8/27/10, and 11/26/10; or monthly EFT payments of \$20.83 on the 15<sup>th</sup> of the month; or \$5.00 per week, per ticket, will be deducted from the paycheck of SAH employees beginning April 1, 2010. Checks are to be made payable to FSAH Money Tree Raffle.
8. Each ticket is entitled to participate in all weekly drawings, Bonus Entry drawings and Grand Prize drawings and receives one free admission to the 2011 Grand Prize Celebration.
9. There shall be three drawings to take place on the Thursday/Friday of each week for 50 consecutive weeks. Drawings shall begin on April 1, 2010. The first drawing will award a cash prize of \$100.00; the second drawing will award a Bonus Entry ball that will be added at the Grand Prize Raffle Celebration; and the third drawing will award a cash prize of \$25. All participants whose payment is current (the amount due by that time has been paid) are eligible for all weekly raffles with the exception of the winner of the first prize, who will not be eligible for the second or third prizes and the winner of the second prize who will not be eligible for the third prize. Participants entering the raffle after March 19, 2010 forfeit all rights to prior weekly drawings of which they were not eligible.
10. All ticket holders current in payment will be entitled to one chance per ticket to each weekly drawing. Additionally, each time a ticket holder wins the weekly Bonus Chance drawing, he/she will be eligible for one additional chance for the Grand Prize, Second Prize and Third Prize at the Grand Prize Raffle Celebration.
11. The Grand Prize drawing will take place March 11, 2011. Ticket holders need not be present to win. Three prizes will be awarded as well as the 50th weekly drawing. All raffle participants current in payment will be eligible for all prizes with the exception of the Grand Prize winner who will be ineligible for the second prize and third prize; and the second prize winner who will be ineligible for the third prize.
12. Depositing the raffle ticket or any other material in connection with the raffle in the Federal mail without proper authorization may be a violation of Federal law and may lead to criminal penalties.
13. The value of the prize will be treated as ordinary income to the winner for Federal and State Income Tax purposes. The winner may be required to pre-pay a portion of the tax liability prior to receiving the prize.
14. The Internal Revenue Service takes the position that no portion of the raffle ticket price will qualify as a charitable contribution for Federal Income Tax purposes.
15. All drawings will be random and will be accomplished by drawing a numbered ball from a locked bin.
16. Proceeds, excluding all prizes and expenses, will be donated to Saint Anne's Hospital, a 501(c)(3) designated charitable organization. Funds will be allocated to the Friends of Saint Anne's Hospital and their efforts to support Saint Anne's Hospital.
17. No proceeds from the raffle will benefit any individual, member or employee of the Hospital.
18. No representations or disclosures are being made or implied except those explicitly set forth in this disclosure statement, or upon the face of the ticket itself. No person selling or delivering raffle tickets or disclosure statements has the authority to make any representations. **Group Ticket Policy**- For the protection of each group member the following Group Ticket policy has been implemented:

**1)** The ticket must be **paid in full** at time of purchase, \$250; **2)** Groups must **divide the \$250 ticket cost evenly** among members; **3)** Group tickets **are not eligible for payroll deduction or EFT**. Cash, check, or credit card only; **4)** Upon ticket purchase the Group must provide the name of a **Team Captain** and a list of all those included in the purchase of a ticket including each team member's address and SS#; **5)** The Team Captain completes the ticket order form and attaches list. **6)** The Group, as a benefit of the ticket, will receive **one** admission to the Grand Prize Celebration. Additional tickets will be available for purchase; **7)** All cash prizes will be divided equally and awarded to each team member.
